REFLECTION

Message from "Rt Rev Kieran Conry, Bishop of Arundel and

Brighton Diocese, who also has responsibility in England and Wales for evangelisation, who said:

"Every November throughout the world those who have died are especially remembered and prayed for by the Catholic community. The commemoration begins on 2nd of the month on a day called All Souls when Catholics pray for the dead as they continue, ahead of the living, the journey into the fullness God's Light.

Catholics also pray for those who are left behind and are still grieving.

These prayers continue throughout the month of November, with people encouraged to visit a church or cemetery to pray."

"Know that, even if you are not a Catholic, you and your loved ones will be prayed for and remembered during November.

Jesus Christ conquered death through his own suffering and death on a cross and by his resurrection. In Him is the source of our hope and light whatever darkness we might currently face. His love for us and those that we love is endless."

We all have God-given talents. How I own and use them makes a

difference, for God, for the community, for the family

and for the whole of creation.

Three servants receive talents from "the master", each

according to what suits him. Two of these servants achieve ownership of their talents and make them productive while waiting for their master's return. The third does nothing with what he is given. The talent wasn't really his. "It was yours, you have it back"

A talent is not really appreciated until I make it mine, adding value to it. God has entrusted me with Godgiven gifts so that I increase my interest in him, in others and in the whole of his creation. After all, God has invested so much in me as a human being, "created in his own image". How can I respond to all this investment in me? Is God inviting me to increase my interest on his account to invest in more people through me, and so contribute to the building up of God's reign, "where there is love and charity, God is there."

This links up with the first reading describing a "perfect wife" who is aware of how she has been gifted by God. She uses these God-given talents not only for her household, but also for the community at large.

The second reading invites us to be continuously aware of the Lord's invisible yet active presence in our lives. This makes us always alert, ready to meet him without fear whenever that "Day" comes.

So we have an invitation to do our best with our Godgiven talents. A talent is always a talent. There is no need to compare ourselves with others. To do our best does not mean striving to be the best. It means simply that, through our constant effort, every kind word, deed, or thought counts before God. This can make a huge difference to our family, to our community and to our world.
