### Homíly Notes

St Vincent was not a Saint from birth. He was born in a poor family in the South of France. As a teenager he fled the poverty of his village, went to the seminary was ordained and began to build a secure future as a priest.



He began to change when he started to truly see the misery of the people among whom he was working. It made him devote his life to God in the service of the poor.

Who taught St Vincent to see? Jesus! In today's Gospel we heard: when Jesus <u>saw</u> the crowds, he felt sorry for them because they were harassed and dejected.

Jesus teaches us to see. When Jesus sees he is not just looking. His seeing is like entering the real life of the other. And when Jesus sees, he allows his heart to be touched, he feels compassion.

To truly see is the first step, and to be moved with compassion is the second step. It does not stop here. Compassion leads to practical action. This is the third step.

Likewise with St Vincent; when he started seeing truly the reality of the poor in Paris, it changed his life. It made him more compassionate and act in favour of them.

What do <u>we</u> see when we look around us? We do not see the misery of the poor of the 17th century, but there are many other situations which would touch our hearts: we think about those who are lonely, those who are sick, those who arrive on our shores without anything, the state of our Mother Earth.

Today we ask St Vincent, that we may follow his example, that our hearts may beat with compassion, and that we may act with hope, in favour of God's Kingdom. *Ferdinard*
